The Weakley County Public Works Committee met on Monday, January 11, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in the conference room at the Board of Education in Dresden. Others present included Road Supervisor Charles Ross, Finance Director John Liggett, and Mayor Jake Bynum.

I.-II. CALL TO ORDER – APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairperson Doster called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and called for the consideration of the minutes from the meeting that was held on December 1, 2020. Commissioner VanCleave made the motion to approve, and with a second by Commissioner Donaldson, the motion passed unanimously.

III. OLD BUSINESS

There was some discussion about the newly formed County Road Acceptance, Change, and Closure Committee and certain roads that should be discussed by the board. Chairperson Doster suggested that the committee meet to discuss those items.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. RESOLUTION

1. Resolution No. 2021-30:

This resolution authorizes a 2021 County Maintenance Road List. Road Supervisor Ross said that there are no additions to the list, but that corrections have been made and are listed at the end of the document. There was brief conversation regarding the document and the corrections list. Commissioner Donaldson made the motion to approve the resolution and recommend it to the full county commission, and with a second by Commissioner Westbrook, the motion passed unanimously.


V. OTHER BUSINESS

VI. ADJOURN


