Chairperson Owen recognized Mayor Bynum who spoke on behalf of judges and other elected and appointed officials who had collectively sent a letter to the commission advocating for the inclusion of funds for the COVID-19 related positions at the entrance to the courthouse. Mayor Bynum explained that Weakley County's Courts are governed by a Supreme Court Order in place that requires temperature checks, masks, and distancing measures for all individuals in the court. There was brief discussion about allocations and potential reimbursement through CARES Act funding for these expenses.

Commissioner Doster made the motion to approve the resolution and recommend it to the full county commission and with a second by Commissioner Westbrook, the motion passed unanimously.


##### **3. Resolution No. 2021-03:**
