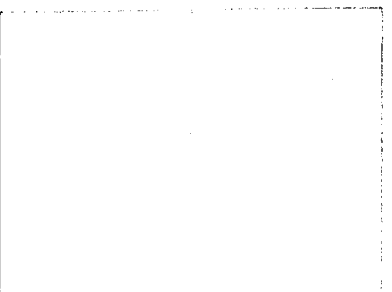
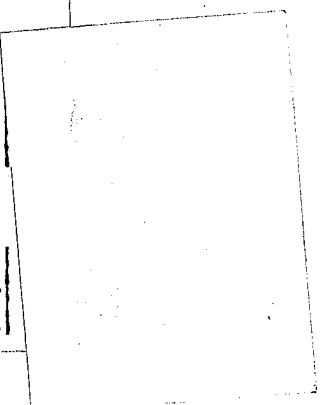

RESOLUTION 1981-32:

A RESOLUTION TO REAPPORTION THE WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY (COUNTY COMMISSION), WEAKLEY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD AND WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, (5-1-111) requires that the County Legislative Body (County Commission) must, prior to January 1, 1982 redistrict the county, if necessary, to secure substantially equal population in each district; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1 of the Tennessee Constitution further requires reapportionment every ten (10) years based on the latest Bureau of the Census data; and

WHEREAS, the 1980 population data from the Bureau of the Census is now available; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Legislative Body (County Commission) is malapportioned according to the 1980 census.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body in its regular meeting, this the 19th day of October, 1981, that the Weakley County Legislative Body (County Commission) is hereby reapportioned as follows:

All calls in the following detailed description of the County Commission Districts are to, with and along the center of all highways, roads, streets, rivers, streams, creeks, branches, ditches and railroads. All calls not along the aforementioned features are in a straight line from point to point.
