The Weakley County Public Works Committee met on Wednesday, November 4, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in the conference room at the Board of Education in Dresden. Others present included County Mayor Jake Bynum, Finance Director John Liggett, Road Supervisor Charles Ross, and a representative of the media.

I.-II. CALL TO ORDER – APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairperson Doster called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and called for the consideration of the minutes from the meeting that was held on September 10, 2020. Commissioner Donaldson made the motion to approve, and with a second by Commissioner Taylor, the motion passed unanimously.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. RESOLUTION

1. Resolution No. 2021-20: This resolution moves \$4,500 out of the unassigned fund balance and places those monies into 116-55751-399 [Solid Waste/Sanitation – Recycling Center – Other Contracted Services] in the Solid Waste Fund Budget. Mayor Bynum was recognized and explained that Weakley County Government’s Annual Solid Waste Report is coordinated through the Northwest Tennessee Development District (NWTNDD), and that the state has always provided grant funding to the entity for the cost of compiling and submitting the report to the state. He went on to say that due to COVID-19, the grant would not be available for the next year. He further explained that the report is mandatory for all governmental entities operating their own solid waste department, and the recommendation is to pay the NWTNDD to continue reporting. There was discussion regarding penalties for non-submission and the financial burden to the county. Commissioner Donaldson made the motion to approve and recommend the resolution to the Finance, Ways, and Means Committee, and with a second by Commissioner Taylor, the motion passed unanimously.


V. OTHER BUSINESS

Supervisor Ross was recognized and provided an update on the Highway Department construction project and said that the fuel station is now up and running. He went on to mention a few roads and bridge repair updates and talked a bit about the road depth reclamation process.


VI. ADJOURN
