

ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE IN
 WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1977.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in Dresden, Tenn. on this 11th day of July 1977, that the combined property tax rate for Weakley County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1977, shall be \$3.37 on each \$100.00 of taxable property, which is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:

Fund	Rate

Highway	.97
General Purpose School	.93
Lebt Service	.79
Total	<u>\$3.37</u>

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby levied a gross receipts tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the gross receipts tax herein levied shall accrue to the County General Fund.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.
