1997-98 FY TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY
GENERAL FUND, WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT,
DEBT SERVICE, WEAKLEY COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
AND SOLID WASTE FUND

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Legislature has not adopted the final 1997-98 FY Budget for the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, county revenue from the state budget is vital to preparing the Weakley County Revenue and Expenditure Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of Commissioners in its regular meeting, this the 23rd of May, 1997, that the adopted Weakley County 1996-97 General Fund, Highway Department, Dept. of Education, Debt Service and Solid Waste Budgets be adopted as the 1997-98 FY Tentative Budgets; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no more than 1/12th of any line item may be expended per calendar month by each Department without the approval of the Weakley County Board of Commissioners' Finance, Ways and Means Committee until the final 1997-98 FY Budget is adopted.
