

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-12

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE RULES REGULATING THE PROCEDURES OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners has previously adopted rules of procedure for the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Committee on Committees has met and recommended that the rules be amended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEAKLEY COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING IN REGULAR SESSION ON JULY 28, 1997, as follows:

SECTION 1. Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure of the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners is hereby amended by deleting the last sentence of Subsection J. and adding the following language:

“Any request or recommendation by a committee to the full commission for its consideration must be passed by a majority vote of the full membership of the committee.”

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective upon passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
