

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-15

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1998.
