RESOLUTION NO. 1999-10

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF
SURPLUS COUNTY REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, Weakley County has owned 131 acres of land located on Weakley County Nursing Home Road since October of 1885; and

WHEREAS, this property has been financially and agriculturally unproductive for several years; and

WHEREAS, there appears that Weakley County has no immediate or future need for this property; and

WHEREAS, this property should be returned to private ownership and placed on the tax rolls.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Weakley County meeting in regular session on this the 27th day of July, 1998, in Dresden, Tennessee, that:


SECTION 1. The Capital Projects and Nursing Home Committees are jointly directed to have the property surveyed and allocated between Nursing Home and County Farm property.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance be directed to dispose of, by public auction or any other legal means determined to be most advantageous to the County, that part of the land determined to be surplus.

SECTION 3. This resolution takes effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners.


