
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR THE REVIEW, COORDINATION AND AREAWIDE DIRECTION OF OPEN-SPACE PLANNING IN WEAKLEY COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Regional Planning Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) is currently carrying on comprehensive planning for the future growth of the Weakley County area;

WHEREAS, such Commission and the members appointed thereto have been duly confirmed by the Tennessee State Planning Commission as the Weakley County Regional Planning Commission with jurisdictional powers extending to the boundaries of Weakley County;

WHEREAS, the provision and preservation of adequate open-space to meet the needs of increased population and physical expansion of Weakley County is of primary importance to the implementation of such planning, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for an interjurisdictional coordinating arrangement which will provide for review, coordination and areawide direction relating to open-space programs likely to develop in Weakley County in the near future;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Weakley County Quarterly Court on this October 12, 1970 assembled in regular business session, that said Quarterly Court does hereby authorize the County Judge to enter into and execute such intergovernmental agreements as may be necessary to provide for the review, coordination and areawide direction of open-space planning as referred to herein.

The foregoing resolution was, on motion duly made and seconded, adopted by the Weakley County Quarterly Court, Weakley County, Tennessee, on October 12, 1970/

Motion was made by Esq. Joe C. Hunt and seconded by Esq. Joe T. Hutcherson on this above resolution. Upon being put to a voice vote, same was carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE SHERIFF ADDITIONAL FEE FOR BOARDING PRISONERS

and;
WHEREAS, The cost of feeding prisoners has greatly increased in the past few years and;
WHEREAS, the Sheriff is presently receiving one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per day for Jailor's fee for each twenty-four (24) hour period a prisoner is confined in the county Jail and;

WHEREAS, Sections 8-2507 and 8-2508, Tennessee Code Annotated (Chapter 319, Public Acts of 1963) provides for an additional twenty-five cents (\$.25) per day for jailor's fee for each twenty-four (24) hour period a prisoner is confined in the county jail.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Sheriff of Weakley County be paid one dollar and seventy-five cents (\$1.75) per day for jailor fee for each twenty-four (24) hour period a prisoner is confined in the county jail.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of this resolution be effective from September 1, 1970. Duly passed and approved this 12 day of October, 1970.
