A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A COURTHOUSE RENOVATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court at its April Term has adopted a resolution authorizing the expenditure of an amount up to \$30,000.00 for the complete renovation of the courthouse, both inside and outside, and,

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to write specifications, advertiz for bids, examine bids, and enter into a contract and other matters pertaining to completion of this work.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court at this, its April Term, that a Courthouse Renovation Committee be established with the authority to write specifications, advertize for bids, accept a bid, enter into a contract, inspect work being done, accept or reject work when completed, and all other matters pertaining to this renovation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this committee shall consist of the County Judge, Squire R. A. Bell, Squire Clyde Miles, and Squire James Porter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if and when there is money in the budget to pay per diem for committee meetings, this committee shall be paid in the same manner and amount as other committees of this court.

Motion made by Esq. Tom D. Copeland and seconded by Esq. Johnny Tharpe that the foregoing Resolution be approved. Upon being put to a voice vote, same carried unanimously.
