

RESOLUTION NO. 1978-25:

## A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 1978-79 BUDGET APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION (#1978-79) FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session on July 10, 1978, adopted the Weakley County Appropriation Budget for FY 1978-79; and

WHEREAS, the approved budget was forwarded to the Comptroller of the Treasury, State of Tennessee, for final approval, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the Treasury noted that in the detailed line items of the Budget two fund transfers, as listed below, had been made but were not included in the Appropriation Resolution (Resolution 1978-79);

- a. Transfer \$127,210.00 from the Highway Fund to Debt Service Fund.
- b. Transfer \$30,000.00 from Debt Service Fund-Refunding to Debt Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners in its regular meeting on October 9, 1978, that Resolution # 1978-19 (Weakley County Appropriation Resolution) be amended as follows:

a. Highway Fund:

Add: New line after Capital Outlay as follows:

Transfer to Debt Service Fund \$127,210.00

CHANGE: Total Highway Fund to read \$ 2,271,322.00

b. Debt Service-Refunding Fund:

Add: New line after Interest on Bonds as follows:

Transfer to Debt Service Fund \$30,000.00

CHANGE: Total Debt Service-Refunding Fund to read \$505,700.00.
