RESOLUTION NO. 1979-29:

RESOLUTION CALLING ON CONGRESS TO RE-ENACT THE GENERAL REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the General Revenue Sharing Program has been in effect since 1972 and has been of inestimable value to Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has appropriated \$360,000 from revenue sharing funds for educational purposes for fiscal year 1979-80; and

WHEREAS, the failure to re-enact General Revenue Sharing would place a tremendous additional tax burden on the property owners of the county; and

WHEREAS, the federal government has the most means available to efficiently and effectively collect taxes; and

WHEREAS, the greatest value of revenue sharing is that those monies are expended at the local level for locally determined priorities; and,

WHEREAS, any reduction in the portion of revenue sharing funds allotted to the state would inevitably result in a reduction of present state aid to Weakley County for other purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners, assembled in regular session this 9th day of July, 1979, do hereby call on Congress to re-enact the General Revenue Sharing Program as presently constituted, with no strings or conditions attached.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to Senator James Sasser, Senator Howard Baker and Congressman Ed. Jones.
