JUVENILE DISTRICT COURT PRIVATE ACT:

The private act consist of: The Constitution two years ago passed a law that a Co. Executive could not be the Judge of Co. Court. This Court will probable be changed to General Sessions Court in the year of 1982. Some of the Judges in North West Tennessee or all seven (7) are not happy with the fact that a juvenile will be handoled in the same court as an adult. They have been working with some State Persons with LEAA and have gotten a grant for a pilot program to form a juvenile district court, of three or four Counties and that grant money will be availabe in September to establish a pilot program a one program in the State so the Legislator can look at another area other than General Sessions Court. It would be a Circuit Rider, come into this Co. if Weakley County is sellected, there are seven (7) Counties in this area, they will select only three (3). Whatever Counties are selected to participate in this program will require a Private Act in this Legislator.

Affidavit passed around for Commissioners to sign in order to assure the Speaker of the House that the County Court will ratify this Private Act in the next term of Court, if passed.

We, the undersigned County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, do hereby agree to vote to ratify a Private Act passed by the Tennessee General Assembly creating a district juvenile court of which Weakley County, Tennessee, is one of several counties in the district.
