

RESOLUTION 1989-49

RESOLUTION STATING THE DECISION OF
WEAKLEY COUNTY NOT TO CONTRACT
WITH THE STATE OF TENNESSEE TO HOUSE CERTAIN CONVICTED FELONS

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated 41-8-106 established the right of a county to voluntarily accept the responsibility to house certain felons from Weakley County convicted of felony offenses beginning July 1, 1992;

WHEREAS, this governing body considered the option for contracting with the Tennessee Department of Correction pursuant to Department of Correction Rule 0420-2-3.03 for the period November 1, 1989 to June 30, 1994;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; Weakley County Chooses not to exercise its option to contract with the State;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk promptly transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Commissioner, Tennessee Department of Correction, Rachel Jackson Building, Fourth Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37219.
