## RESOLUTION NO. 1990-44 <br> RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE JAILER'S FEE OF WEAKLEY COUNTY

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-26-105, authorizes county legislative bodies to pass a resolution fixing the amount of jailer's fees which may be applied to misdemean prisoners for each calendar day the prisoner is confined to the local facility, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weakly County fixed the jailer's fee at $\$ 15.00$ per misdemeanor prisoner per calendar day of confinement by Resolution No. 1987-20; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County desires to increase the jailer's fee from $\$ 15.00$ to $\$ 18.00$.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, meeting this 16th day of July, 1990, that:

SECTION 1. The jailer's fee for Weakley County is hereby increased from $\$ 15.00$ to $\$ 18.00$ per misdemeanor prisoner per calendar day of confinement.

SECTION 2. The jailer's fee herein fixed shall be collected by the clerk of the appropriate court as a part of the fines and costs imposed in each misdemeanor case upon a finding of guilt.

SECTION 3. A Copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to each clerk of a court hearing criminal matters in Weakley County and shall be spread upon the minutes of this meeting by the county clerk.

This resolution shall take effect upon adoption, the general welfare requiring it.
