RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH OBION-FORKED DEER BASIN AUTHORITY
FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS FOR
THE BENEFIT OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 7

WHEREAS, Weakley County recognizes the need to maintain that portion of the Middle Fork Obion River under the supervision of Drainage District known as No. 7 and,

WHEREAS, the Obion-Forked Deer Basin Authority Board of Directors at its October 1990 meeting did authorize assistance to that Drainage District on a reimbursement basis up to \$4,000 for a twelve (12) month period of such maintenance cost as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Weakley County
Commission authorize the County Executive to enter into a contract with Obion-Forked Deer Basin Authority for the purpose of receiving reimbursement funds for the benefit of Drainage
District No. 7. The funds shall be paid only for specific itemized maintenance costs on that reach of Middle Fork Obion River under Drainage District No. 7's jurisdiction.
