RESOLUTION NO. 1991-35

TO CREATE A COUNTY PUBLIC RECORDS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-401 $\underline{\text{et}}$ $\underline{\text{seq}}$, provides that the county legislative body of each county may create a county public records commission; and

WHEREAS, such a commission consists of a member of the which holds court in the county, the county clerk, register of deeds, county historian (if there is one) and a recognized genealogist residing within the county who is not on a public payroll (if there is one). The judge member shall be selected and designated by a majority vote of all the judges of courts of record holding court in the county and such designation shall be record holding court in the county and such designation shall be entered upon the minutes of each court of record in the county. The genealogist shall be appointed by the presiding officer of the governing body of the county. If the judges of the courts of record should fail to designate a member or a successor to serve on such commission within sixty (60) days, the county legislative body shall select the member of such group to serve.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body meeting in regular session on this 15th day of April , 19 91 , that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a $\underline{\text{Weakley}}$ County Public Records Commission, the composition of which is outlined above. The county legislative body member to serve on the SECTION 1. There is hereby created a commission is Houston Patrick, Faye Butts, Mike Maloan, Jenny Vaughn, Shirley Buckley and Comm. John Bucy.

SECTION 2. All members shall serve during the term of

the office by virtue of which they serve on the commission.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect passage, the public welfare requiring it.
