

**RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AN ARCHIVES AND RECORDS
MANAGEMENT FEE IN WEAKLEY COUNTY
AS AMENDED SEE BACK OF RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 10-7-408, authorizes county legislative bodies to establish and collect an archives and records management fee not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per document filed in county offices creating public records, except the register of deeds, with the funds collected through this fee to be designated exclusively for duplicating, storing, and maintaining any records required by law to be permanently kept; and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body, having established a county public records commission as required by law, has determined that it is in the best interests of the county that such an archives and records management fee be established and collected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session in Dresden, Tennessee, that:

SECTION 1. An archives and records management fee is hereby established in the amount of two dollars (\$2.00) per document filed in all county offices creating public records, including but not limited to the county clerk, the county trustee, the sheriff, the county property assessor, the county mayor, and the county legislative body (but not including the register of deeds and clerks of court).

SECTION 2. An archives and records management fee is hereby established in the amount of two dollars (\$2.00) per document filed with the clerks of all courts in Weakley County for the purpose of initiating a legal proceeding.

SECTION 3. The funds collected through this fee shall be remitted to the county general fund to be appropriated for use exclusively for duplicating, storing, and maintaining records required by law to be permanently kept.

SECTION 4. The fee imposed by this resolution shall take effect January 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.

SECTION 5. Upon passage and approval of this resolution, a copy shall be mailed or delivered in person by the County Clerk to every office responsible for collecting the fee imposed by this resolution.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to that end the provisions of this resolution are declared to be severable.






