County Mayor Patrick made the motion for Shawn Francisco to serve as Recording Secretary and with a second by Commissioner Owen the motion passed unanimously.


The committee began the tour of the surplus properties and recessed at 7:25 a.m.

The committee reconvened at 8:50 a.m. at the Weakley County Courthouse. Discussion followed on the five properties for sale. Mrs. Collins explained to the committee the county tax sale is schedule for Monday, September 17, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. and these properties could be sold at that sale. Commissioner Owen made the motion to sell these five properties at the county tax sale on September 17, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. with Mrs. Collins administering the auction and if these properties did not sell this committee would meet afterwards to take other action. County Mayor Patrick seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The committee requested Mrs. Francisco to contact the cities to make a determination of the final taxes due on each property. Mrs. Collins said she would advertise these five properties for the tax sale.

Commissioner Owen made the motion to adjourn and with a second by County Mayor Patrick the meeting adjourned at 9:24 a.m.
