

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENT
FOR WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE HIGHWAY FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015**

WHEREAS, Weakley County is receiving revenue from the Tennessee Department of Transportation funded at 98% for the purpose of construction of Powell Levee Bridge; and

WHEREAS, TDOT requires a 2% local match and these funds are available in unassigned account; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 27th day of January, 2015 in Dresden, Tennessee that this resolution is hereby approved.

SECTION 1. The Weakley County Highway Fund is hereby amended as follows:


