

RESOLUTION 2011-06

RESOLUTION TO CREATE AND APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND JAIL PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, although the public buildings of Weakley County appear to be well maintained, many counties have created a commission to make recommendations to the county legislative body for needed improvements to public buildings; and

WHEREAS, Section 5-5-120 Tennessee Code Annotated authorizes counties to create such a commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-108, TCA provides that the custody of the Courthouse is placed with the Sheriff if the county legislative body does not provide otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body has previously by resolution, placed the custody of the courthouse with the County Mayor.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on this 26th day of July, 2010, that:

SECTION 1. There is created a County Courthouse and Jail Public Improvements Commission as provided by Section 5-5-120, TCA.



Motion to recind Resolution 2011-06 was made by Commissioner VanCleave and a second was placed by Commissioner Chandler.


