

ROAD RESOLUTION.

Whereas, It appearing to the members of the Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, now assembled; that the Weakley County Highway Department is now paying 5% interest on certain, lumber claims, issued by this Department, amounting to \$8770.28. We feel that we can secure this money at a much cheaper rate of interest and pay said claims, thereby saving the County the difference in the rate of interest and at the same time not raising the County indebtedness. AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO the Court that there is not sufficient funds now on hand to pay said claims.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, a majority of the Justices of the Peace of the County being present and a majority voting therefor, that the Weakley County Road Board, be empowered to borrow the sum of \$8770.28, payable March 15th, 1944 at a rate of interest not more than 3½% per annum, said sum to be used by the Highway Department for the sole and only purpose of paying the above mentioned lumber claims issued by this Department. That said sum so

borrowed to be paid out of the Bridge and Levee fund. To secure said indebtedness the note to be signed by the Road Superintendant, the County Court Clerk and the County Judge for the use and benefit of Weakley County, Tennessee.

PASSED BY Justices of the Peace voting therefor and duly approved and adopted by the Quarterly County Court.

By motion of I. G. Hatler and seconded by B. N. Wheeling the above resolution was adopted by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session, the equal distributions to all districts in the said repair work
