ROAD RESOLUTION

Whereas, It appearing to the members of the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, now assembled, that the gravel roads in Weakley County, Tennessee, will become impassible to the general public unless there is more gravel added to same.

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that there is not sufficient funds now on hand to pay said gravel .

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, a majority of the Justices of the Peace now of the County being present and a majority voting therefor, that the Weakley County Road Board be empowered to borrow the sum of (\$10,000.00) TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS, payable in monthly installments of (\$500.00) FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS each beginning May 15th, 1944 at a rate of interest not more than 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ % per annum. Said sum to be used by the Highway Department of the County for the sole and only purpose of paying for the gravel to repair said roads. That said sum so borrowed to be paid out of the County Gasoline tax. To secure said indebtedness the note to be signed by the Road Supervisor, the County Court Clerk and the County Judge for the use and benefit of Weakley County, Tennessee.

By motion of John C. Hatler and seconded by R.R. Wright the above resolution was adopted and that said amount so borrowed to be used to repair gravel roads with equal distribution of all districts in said repair work. Said resolution was duly adopted by the Quarterly Court in regular session.
