



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUARTERLY COUNTY COURT IN REGULAR SESSION, That from and after this date the Weakley County Beer Board shall have the power to refuse permits to sell, store or handle beer within two thousand feet of a Church, or School house, and shall have the power to revoke any permit now in existance for the sale, storage of handling of beer if the place of business be within two thousand feet of a school house or Church. This resolution is passed for the purpose of giving such Beer Board authority to exercise and to put into effect the provisions of law relative to the sale of beer within two thousand feet of a church or school house, which is left descretionary with the governing body of the County.
