
RESOLUTION

Whereas, on the _____ day of August, 1943, the Ralston Public School Building at Ralston, in Weakley County, Tennessee, was destroyed by fire, and it is insisted by Weakley County and the County Board of Education of Weakley County, that the fire which destroyed said building was set out by one of the locomotives of the Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway;

AND WHEREAS, the Liverpool, London and Globe Insurance Company, had issued a policy insuring said building against loss by fire in the sum of \$600.00, and has paid said insurance in said sum of \$600.00 to the County Board of Education of Weakley County and said board has executed to said insurance company a subrogation agreement;

AND WHEREAS, The Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway has offered to pay to Weakley County Board of Education the sum of \$450.00 and to said insurance company the sum of \$550.00 in full and final settlement of said claim, and said Weakley County Board of Education and insurance company have agreed to receive said respective sums in full and final settlement of their respective claims, and execute releases in favor of The Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway.

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved, by the Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, at its regular session in the Court House at Dresden, Tennessee; on the first Monday in April, 1944, that the Weakley County Board of Education be and is authorized and empowered to consummate said settlement and upon the payment of \$450.00 to said Weakley County Board of Education and the payment of \$550.00 to said insurance company by The Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway, the Weakley County Board of Education will execute and deliver to said Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway, a full and final discharge and release.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payment of the sums aforesaid by The Nashville, Chattanooga & St. Louis Railway shall forever release and discharge it from any and all liability to Weakley County as a result of said fire.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be entered upon the minutes of the County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee.
