WHEREAS, it appears that there are many tracts of land located within the boundaries of Middle Fork and Spring Creek Drainage District on which there are delinquent drainage assessments and many years of delinquent state and county taxes, and

Whereas, it appears that many of the owners of said tracts of land are being afforded the opportunity of pay such delinquent drainage assessments at a greatly reduced figure, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the County Court has through the years made provision of reductions in payments of county taxes on lands in such drainage district.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUARTERLY COURT in REGULAR SESSION, That all county taxes assessed against the various tracts of land located within said drainage district, now delinquent, may from and after this date be paid at the rate of Twenty-Five (25¢) Cents on the dollar of the original assessment. The remaining Seventy-Five (75¢) Cents on the dollar of such original assessments is hereby waived, released and discharged. All penalties and interest on the delinquent assessments are waived, released and discharged. The Honorable Cayce Pentecost, County Judge and Financial Agent of the County, is hereby empowered and authorized to sign and execute on behalf of the county all such credit memoranda, receipts and releases as may be necessary to satisfy the records of the Trustee and the Clerk and Master of the Chancery Court for the Seventy-Five (75¢) Cents on the dollar of such original assessments and for all the penalties and interest accrued and accumulated on the whole of such original assessments; and, if necessary, in order to satisfy the records of such two offices, the County Judge, County Court Clerk, Chairman of Road Commission, and Chairman and Secretary of the Board of Education are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to draw warrants in favor of the Trustee and Clerk and Master on the county funds against which they are authorized by law to draw warrants for such separate funds proportionate part of such assessments, penalties and interest forgiven, released and discharged by this resolution. This resolution shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by this Court.

The above resolution in regard to the delinquent drainage assessments of the Middle Fork and Spring Creek Drainage District were carried unanimously by regular roll call vote.
