To the Honorable Court of Weakley County
Cayce Pentecost, Judge.

Gentlemen:

Whereas, the budgets naming the amounts of anticipated income for school purposes, both high school and elementary, from both state and county, also the anticipated expenditures for both high school and elementary, were approved by this Court at the April session; and,

Whereas, since the approval of these budgets, the Tennessee Legislature has appropriated extra money sufficient to add \$20.00 per month, for eight months to the annual salary of every public school teacher within the state for the year 1944-45; and,

Whereas, it was impossible at the time these budgets were approved to determine the amounts of "Unencumbered cash balance at beginning of school year for which these budgets were made",

Be it resolved:

First, that these budgets be so revised as to include this raise in salary for all teachers; and,

Second, that the budgets be further revised so as to make the items reading "Unencumbered cash balance....." the exact figures obtained by the actual cash balance as of June 30, 1944; and the expenditures affected by these changes be so revised as to make a true balance.

These resolutions submitted this the _____ day of July, 1944, as a revision to the budgets adopted by this Court at the April session.
