Gentlemen:

Whereas, there is set up in the school budget for the school year 1944-1945 sufficient funds under the caption --

"Capital Outlay" -- arabic numeral 6 which reads "New Service System Equipment (Heating Lighting, bus, etc.) to pay for two new buses; and,

Whereas, the bulk of the school funds derived from taxes does not accumulate in the Trustee's office before February, and

Whereas, there is now a dire need for purchasing two new buses;

Be it resolved that the Judge, County Court Clerk, and Superintendent be empowered to borrow funds sufficient to purchase two new buses; and,

Be it further resolved that this note shall be made against the school funds and shall be liquidated when sufficient funds have accumulated.
