

The Honorable Cayce Pentecost, County Judge, presented a resolution and upon the motion of John C. Hatler, Esquire and the second of Esquire Dean Grooms that the resolution be read, the following resolution is to wit:

BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this the 2nd day of April, 1945, The Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, in regular session, adopted the following resolution.

WHEREAS, in pursuance and under the authority of House bill No. 798, Chapter No. 354, of the Private Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, 1945, The Quarterly County Court for Weakley County, Tennessee, has voted to issue bonds in the amount of \$400,000.00, in the name of the County of Weakley, State of Tennessee, in order to provide funds for the purpose of constructing, building, maintaining, and repairing roads and bridges in Weakley County, Tennessee.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, that when said bonds have been issued and sold and the proceeds arising from the sale of same has been paid over to the County Trustee of Weakley County, Tennessee, as provided in said Act that the proceeds arising from said sale or any part thereof shall not be paid out except by authority and approval of the Weakley County Quarterly Court and upon a warrant signed by the County Judge of Weakley County, Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Highway Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, shall present and file with the County Court Clerk of Weakley County a general budget, showing the amount of funds which they desire to spend out of said bond funds for construction, building, maintaining and repairing roads and bridges in Weakley County, and also a detailed plan and description of the road or roads upon which they expect to spend said money, and this report shall be filed with the County Court Clerk at least ten days before any regular or extra session of said Quarterly County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, which Quarterly County Court may by majority vote approve, reject, revise and recommend any change in the proposed program or any part thereof, and may eliminate from the budget any proposed project or expenditure but may not otherwise modify or change such program. The Board of Highway Commissioners shall not be authorized by this Court or permitted to start the construction, building, maintaining and repairing of said roads and bridges of this County until the Quarterly County Court of Weakley County Authorizes the expenditure set out in the said program or budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is the purpose and intention of the Weakley County Quarterly Court, to have and maintain strict supervision of the expenditure of all money derived from the sale of bonds herein mentioned, as a safeguard to the people of Weakley County.

Esquire Hatler moved that the foregoing Resolution be adopted, which motion was seconded by Esquire Grooms, the members of the Quarterly Court present voting all the Resolution and voting against the Resolution. A majority of the Justices of the Peace of said Quarterly County Court having voted for the Resolution, it was duly adopted by the Court.
