
Be it resolved by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in session at its Regular April Term, 1948, a majority of Justices being present:

1. That all monies derived for the collection of the insurance on the old courthouse, from the sale of any personal items saved from the fire, and the proceeds of all courthouse bonds shall be paid into the hands of C. P. Taylor, Trustee of Weakley County, Tennessee.

2. That the County Trustee, C. P. Taylor, is hereby instructed to deposit all such monies in one or more banks of Weakley County, Tennessee, to a special account known as the account of "C.P. Taylor, Trustee, Courthouse Account"

3. No voucher drawn on such account shall be honored by the County Trustee unless the same shall be drawn on such courthouse account, and shall be signed by the County Judge and countersigned by R. A. Elkins, Chairman, or D. Z. Grooms, Vice-Chairman of the Courthouse Commission.

The above resolution was introduced by Mike Wheeling and seconded by J. C. Hatler. The resolution was declared carried by the following vote:
