

Motion by C. B. Herron, seconded by J. C. Hatler, that the matter of disposing of the old Court House building be left to the Court House Commission, heretofore appointed and elected by the court, and that such commission may dispose of the old Court House Building at any time after the matter of insurance is adjusted, without further leave of this court.

This motion passed by a unanimous voice vote of the Justices present.

A Resolution was made by Esq. C. B. Herron and seconded by Esq. W. B. House and others that the County Judge be authorized to appoint a guard or night watchman to protect the records and other County property in the various places in which the offices of the County are located until the Courthouse can be replaced. The County Judge also be authorized to pay the expense of moving the records and other work in connection with the setting up and relocating of the County offices after the burning of the Courthouse, and that the Judge also be authorized to set and pay a fair salary to the night watchman and also to pay the above mentioned workman according to the prevailing wage scale and that the County Judge be further authorized to pay the various fire departments and fire men a fair and just wage for their participation in fighting the fire at the Courthouse.

The above resolution passed by a unanimous voice vote of the Court.
