WHEREAS' it is evident that there will be a few needy families whose children must be furnished clothing and receive help if they are to attend school regularly,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 1947-1948 school budget be increased for this purpose not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and that the educational the authority to allow the expenditure of these funds as the need arises.
