
R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, there is a road which extended north and south directly along the property line between the T. L. Johnson property (now owned by Bell Clay Company) and the L.P. Darnell property (now a one-third interest in which is owned by Bell Clay Company), with respect to which authority was heretofore given by Honorable Cayce Pentecost, County Judge of Weakley County, Tennessee, to cut out that portion of the road directly south of the Winstead and Pinkston property for a distance of approximately six hundred (600) feet and

WHEREAS, as soon as said road was cut a by-pass was opened, commencing approximately four hundred (400) yards south of the Winstead and Pinkston property, which by-pass turned east onto the Johnson property and then paralleled the old roadway until it reached the south Pinkston line where it turned due west making contact with the old road, which by-pass has been kept open and passable at all times by Bell Clay Company; and

WHEREAS, question has arisen as to whether or not said road was ever a public road of Weakley County, Tennessee or accepted, appropriated or used as one of the public roads of Weakley County, or whether the road now serves any public purpose which would require its designation and maintenance as a public road of said County, there being only one individual now living beyond the point where said by-pass was constructed, and said individual having access at will to said road, including said by-pass, for all necessary and proper purposes, and it is now desired to officially determine and settle all questions relating to said road or maintenance thereof, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Highway Commission of Weakley County, Tennessee that said road be, and it hereby is disclaimed as a public road, or if ever received, accepted or treated as a public road at any time heretofore that the same be, and it hereby is, abandoned as a public road.

The above resolution passed until Oct. Term of Court subject to recommendations of Magistrates of the 25th Civil Dist.

The herein resolution adopted and approved with the consent and approval of the quarterly Court, and it is hereby referred to the Oct. Term of Quarterly Court for the consideration and support of the property owners along said road and the magistrates of the 24th Civil District.
