
A RESOLUTION

Be it remembered that at this meeting of the Quarterly Court it was ordered that our representatives in the next Legislature be requested to consider a change in the present road law in that the commissioners be elected by the people of the various road dostricts instead of being elected by the Qyarterly Court, and that the commissioners thus elected employ a supervisor, all of which shall be in strict compliance of the road law in force at that particular time.

And in connection with this move it was ordered that a committee of five members of this Court be appointed by the Judge to investigate certain changes in the present law, to go to other counties if they think necessary and to do whatever they think wise in determining the best movement to give the people of the county a road law that is workable and one that will meet the approval of the people.
