Whereas; the Weakley County Board of Education deems it necessary to begin certain building programs early this spring in order to complete such projects prior to the next school term, and

Whereas; the said Board of Education feels it probably necessary to issue tax anticipation notes in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 in order to get these projects started; and

Whereas; section 49-202 of the Code of Tennessee authorizes a Quarterly County Court to issue such notes, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Weakley County Quarterly Court duly assembled hereby authorizes the issuance of Tax Anticipation note or notes in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 against the credit of Weakley County, but more specifically against the anticipated revenue from the School Expansion Fund of the 1958-59 budget;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Weakley County Quarterly Court hereby authorizes the County Judge, County School Superintendent, Chairman of the County Board of Education, and County Trustee, to sign said note or notes for Weakley County.
