
RESOLUTION READ BY MRS. NANNEY:

Whereas, due to the lack of work for many of our people during the year 1957-1958 our relief, medicine, hospitalization and other welfare related accounts were not large enough in the 1957 1958 budget to take care of our absolute necessities, and

Whereas, we have had unforeseen expense with our Court House, and

Whereas, we have had expensive unforeseen called elections, and

Whereas, though \$4,500.00 was due the School Department from the 1955-56 and the 1956-56 budget through an oversight, such amount was left out of the 1957-58 budget, but as a matter of fact such amount was needed by the School Department and was paid during the past fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, due to all the above reasons and others, among which is the lack of forecasting skill of the County Judge the 1957-58 General Fund Budget was overspent more than \$5,000.00 now therefore

Be it resolved that the Weakley County Quarterly Court hereby ratify, confirm and authorize the action of the County Judge in overspending the budget in 1957-1958
