Court called to order by the Honorable George Thomas, Jr. Upon a roll call by the Clerk, the following Justices of the Peace answered present:

WHEREUPON, a quorum being declared to be present, the following proceedings were had:

Judge Thomas informed the Court that there would be a vacancy of the Board members of the Weakley County Municipal Electric System on July 1, 1951, namely: A. W. Gaylord whose time expires on July 1, 1951, and asked the Court to permit him to appoint a member for this vacancy. The Court unanimously approved and Milton Roberts was appointed as such member, his term to begin July 1, 1951, for four years. Motion was made by Esq. M. A. Miles, seconded by Esq. Neal Tillman for the foregoing, and same carried, as above stated.

Motion was made by Esq. Bill House, seconded by Esq. Barney Bailey, that the bondsmen of Shobe Smith, Jr., County Court Clerk be heard. Motion carried upon same being put to a vote. Esq. Dean Grooms asked for a report of the audit of the said Shobe Smith, Jr., dated December 16, 1950. Said report was read by Judge Thomas, which covered period of January 7, 1948, to December 16, 1950.

Allen J. Strawbridge read to the Court the Resolution of the bondsmen to appoint a Receiver for said office.

Motion was made by Esq. Dean Grooms, seconded by C. B. Herron, that a lawyer be appointed for the Court to inform the Court the law concerning said Clerk's office, and the deficit shown by above mentioned audit.

Motion was made by Esq. Barney Bailey, seconded by Bill House, to table above motion. A roll call vote was had, which was as follows:
