TO THE MEMBERS OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY COURT WHEN IN REGULAR SESSION AT THE OCTOBER TERM, 1958.

Your attention is hereby called to the fact that the Trustee's report as of October 1, 1958, and shows a balance of \$6,101. 57----- on this day, Monday, October 6th, 1958, has approved the payment of approximately \$1,000.00 for claims filed against the County since the July 1958 session.

Weakley County will not have sufficient funds in the County General Account to pay these bills, and should they be paid by the Trustee there will be a deficit in this account of something like \$4,000.00.

In order to pay these current claims it will be necessary to transfer funds from some of the county accounts to the County general Fund account, which can be done legally by an order of this court to the County Trustee.

Be it therefore ordered by this Court, a quorum being present and a majority voting therefor, that the County Trustee be authorized to transfer the sum of \$4,000.00 from the Debt Service Account and place the same to the credit of the County General Fund Account, the public welfare demanding it.
