

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Court House is now complete and is being occupied. Same stands as a monument to the untiring efforts of the Court House Commission and to every citizen of the County. It is a beautiful and magnificent building and one that does credit to Weakley County, the State of Tennessee, and its citizenship. It would be amiss not to have some dedication service memorializing the effort put forth by the people of Weakley County in the erection of this building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court, met in regular session at its April Term, that a committee composed of five members, one of which will include the County Judge, be appointed to make plans and preparations for a dedicatory service to be held at a date designated by said Committee. Said Committee to be appointed by the County Judge and approved by the Quarterly County Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that every citizen of Weakley County be invited through the public press to attend and help to sponsor said dedicatory service, and that a written invitation by letter be sent to the Chairman of President of every civic organization in the County inviting them to cooperate in the dedication of this building.

The above Resolution was read to the Court, and upon motion being made and duly seconded, same was adopted by a unanimous voice vote of the Court. Thereupon, Judge Cayce Pentecost appointed the following members of the Court to act on the above mentioned Committee, to-wit: Esq. Hassell Collier, Bernie Bailey, Willard Huggins, and George Hearn. The Honorable Cayce Pentecost to act as an Honorary member. The above appointed Committee was duly elected by the Court, and it was so ordered.
