

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session, on October 1, 1951, that this Court tender to the United States of America sufficient space in the Weakley County Court House, in Dresden, Tennessee, which Court House is new, commodious, modernistic, has three Courtrooms, and sufficient office space to house such Court, as a place for the holding of Federal Court, if and when a new Division of the Western District of Tennessee is created by the Congress of the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Estes Kefauver, of the United States Senate, the Honorable K. D. McKellar, of the United States Senate, and the Honorable Jere Cooper, Member of the House of Representatives, for the Ninth Tennessee District.

Motion was made by Esq. Robert Kennedy, seconded by Albert Miles that above resolution be adopted. Carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court, and it was so ordered.
