RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session on October 1, 1951, that it is the sense of the Court that a new Division of the Federal Court for the Western Division of Tennessee should be created by appropriate Act of Congress for the convenience of the people in the Northwest portion of Tennessee, and to the end that the Federal Court be more accessible to the litigants of the locality and to the witnesses and others compelled to attend such Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States Congress be memorialized to pass a bill now pending in the Senate for the creation of a Moving Federal Judgeship for Middle and West Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Estes Kefauver, of the United States Senate, the Honorable K. D. McKellar, of the United States Senate, and the Honorable Jere Cooper, Member of the House of Representatives, for the Ninth Tennessee District.

Motion was made by J. Martin Adams, seconded by Frank Miller that the above resolution be adopted. Carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court, and it was so ordered.
