

PIPELINE RESOLUTION

TO: HON. JOHN C. HAMMER, HON. HAMMOND FOWLER, AND HON. CAYCE L. PENTECOST, MEMBERS,
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, STATE OF TENNESSEE.

WHERE, AMERICAN LOUISIANA PIPELINE COMPANY has proposed to construct a pipeline for the purpose of conveying gas from fields in the State of Louisiana to the State of ~~Michigan~~ Michigan, and

Whereas, said pipeline, as now proposed, would cross the State of Tennessee from north to south and, more particularly would cross a portion of Weakley County, Tennessee and,

WHEREAS, if said pipeline was constructed across said state, and more particularly said county, the income from taxes along occurring to the said Weakley County would be a tremendous help to all of the citizens of said county, and,

WHEREAS, in addition to the revenue derived from taxes, the income to many of the individual citizens of Weakley County, originating from employment and from the purchase of materials used in said construction would be a substantial sum and would be of a continuing nature even after the original construction of said pipeline was completed, and

WHEREAS, it is understood that the Public Service Commission of the State of Tennessee has, in the past, taken legal action before the Federal Power Commission, Washington, D.C. which would have the tendency to block or prohibit the procurement of gas by the American Louisiana Pipeline Company, thereby destroying the need of any such proposed gas line across the State of Tennessee, and, more particularly across Weakley County, Tennessee, and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the construction of such pipeline will be of substantial benefit to this County as a unit of government and to each individual citizen of this County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE WEAKLEY COUNTY QUARTERLY COURT, DRESDEN, TENNESSEE, unanimously requests that the member of the Public Service Commission, State of Tennessee, give this matter much serious study and said court urgently request the members of said Public Service Commission to not only refrain from taking any further action that would in any way block construction of said pipeline but to take positive action to see that said pipeline is constructed across the State of Tennessee and particularly Weakley County, Tennessee, to the end that all of the citizens of Weakley County, Tennessee, may be benefited therefrom.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be retained as a part of the minutes of this meeting of the Weakley County Quarterly court and a copy of said Resolution be sent to each of the members of the Public Service Commission of the State of Tennessee.
