

WHEREAS, it appears that the acquisition of right of ways where the property owners are contending that they are entitled to compensation for such right of ways can best be acquired by a permanent committee of the Weakley County Quarterly Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Weakley County Quarterly Court on this January 8, 1962, that the County Judge be and he is authorized to appoint a committee of five members from this Court to serve on such a committee and that the Tax Assessor of said County be an ex-officio member of such committee.

Upon the above Resolutions being presented it was moved by Esquire Vernon Dunn, seconded by Esquire Leland Lemonds, that said Resolution be adopted and upon such motion being put to a vote it was carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court.

Motion was made by Esq. Vernon Dunn, seconded by Esq. James Grissom, that this Resolution be published in all the newspapers in Weakley County, Tennessee, and, further that the Cities be allowed the use of the services of this Committee in the matter of rights-of-way, if they so desire. Upon such motion being put to a vote, same carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court.

TO THE COUNTY COURT CLERK:

In pursuant to an order of the January 1962 session of Quarterly Court, I hereby appoint Vernon Dunn of Gleason as Chairman of the newly established permanent road condemnation committee, R. Y. Bushart of Dresden, Herman L. Jolley of the 3rd District, Neal Tillman of the 22nd District, and Hillman Westbrook of the 13th District other members of this Committee. Motion was made by Esq. Woodie Whaley, seconded by Esq. Bill Dudley, that J. Duke Priestley be reappointed County Surveyor for Weakley County for a term of one year. Carried by unanimous voice vote of Court.

Motion was made by Esq. Seymour Buckley, seconded by Esq. W. M. Stow, that the County Judge be allowed to pay such bills as in his discretion he thought proper that came in after meeting of Finance Committee. Upon such motion being put to a vote, same carried by unanimous voice vote of the Court.

APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEE RE. NEW REST HOME.

In pursuant to an order of the Weakley County Quarterly Court at the January 1962 regular session, the County Judge was directed to name a committee of three members of this Court to act in cooperation with the County Judge in having the State Department of Public Health to inspect and determine if the old Chestnut Glad School Building was in such condition to be remodeled and converted into a nursing home. And, in pursuant to such order, I, Gayce Pentecost, County Judge, do hereby appoint Esq. Elbert Hays of the 17th Civil District as Chairman of this Committee, Esq. Thomas Radford of the 24th District, and Edq. Russell Dinning of the 11th District. I also name Mr. Harvey Vaughan, Chairman of the Weakley County School Board, as Ex-officio member of this Committee. The appointment of Mr. Vaughan is in order to have some representative of the County School Board represented in the transaction of the school property to Weakley County for the use and purpose of a nursing home.
