

## WEAKLEY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION AS READ BY JUDGE E. W. WHEELING:

R E S O L U T I O N

The Weakley County Board of Education met in the Superintendent's Office on July 24, 1969.

Mr. Danner presented a resolution as follows:

WHEREAS: The Weakley County Board of Education has gone into a "Modernization and Building Program" for the upgrading of education in the Weakley County Public Schools in the amount of \$4,250,000.00.

WHEREAS: The Weakley County Board of Education agrees to accept the recommendation presented by the Weakley County Budget Committee to pledge \$73,000.00 for the year 1969-70 from the local sales tax monies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Weakley County Board of Education agrees to pay \$73,000.00 in the 1969-70 school year to the Weakley County Trustee for Debt Services.

A motion was made by Enlain Killebrew and seconded by Dr. Robert Moore to accept the resolution. Motion carried.

Superintendent Biggs Danner explained this resolution to the Court. Esq. Milton Roberts, Finance Committee Chairman, explained to the Court that htis resolution did not recommend what the Committee had asked for. After much discussion, Esq. Roberts asked for an amendment to this Resolution. Supt. Danner said he did not have the authority to say what the School Board would do as this resolution just covered the year 1969-70 school budget. But he would explain the amendment to the School Board at the next meeting and tell the Court what their decision was at the next Court. It was the opinion of Esq. Roberts to adopt this resolution and if changes were necessary they would be made on the 1970-71 budget.

Esq. Denton Bell made a motion that we adopt this resolution, seconded by Esq. Hillman Westbrook Upon being put to a Roll Call Vote., same carried as follows:
