On the 15th of October, 1984, the County Commissioners met in the County Courtroom in Dresden, Tn. H. C. Brundige called the meeting to order and County Clerk Faye Butts had roll call with 18 present, 2 absent, being Comm. Fred Morris and Comm. Gene Harris. Weakley County Deputy Pam Rickman opened Court and Comm. Sam Sinclair had invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Comm. Charles Culver made a motion to accept the minutes of the July 16, 1984 and Special called meeting of September 4, 1984. Comm. William Mansfield seconded the motion and after a show of hands vote, motion carried.

Lynda Shannon spoke to the open court and told them the Chamber of Commerce appreciated the money the court gave them and will give quarterly reports to them. She said the Chamber would appreciate any input it could give them.

TRUSTEE'S REPORT:

Motion to accept the trustee's report was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Lewis Garner. After a show of hands, motion carried.

GENERAL FUND REPORT:

Motion to accept the General Fund Report was made by Comm. Earl Wright, seconded by Comm. Sam Sinclair. After a show of hands, motion carried.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT REPORT:

Motion to accept the Highway Dept. report was made by Comm. Gerald Caldwell, seconded by Comm. Bobby Parker. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

SCHOOL DEPT. REPORT:

Motion to accept the School Dept. report was made by Comm. V. J. Shanklin, seconded by Comm. Wm. S. Powers. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

NURSING HOME REPORT:

Motion to accept the nursing home report was made by Comm. Joe White, and seconded by Comm. Larry Jolly. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

W. C. M. E. S. REPORT:

Motion to accept the W. C. M. E. S. report was made by Comm. Joe White and seconded by Comm. Wm. Mansfield. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT:

Comm. Westbrook reports to the Court that the State Leg. passed a law saying that if the County Commission don't by 2/3 majority, exempt 100% Disable Veterans from the \$15.00 Wheel Tax, they will. The Leg. Committee recommends we take no action, so January 1, 1985, the DV's will be exempt from the wheel tax. There is also 8 POW's in the county and the committee also voted to exempt them also from the wheel tax.

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT:

Co. Exec. H. C. Brundige wanted to make aware to the Commissioners that the General Fund will probably run low until taxes state coming in and that will not be until December. He and Faye Butts may have to go borrow money if they have to.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE REPORT:

The committee met briefly with the representatives of the Nursing Home and Adm. and assistance for the purpose of discussing the policies set forth in the handbook for the employees of the county, how these policies might be better adapted for the employees of the Nursing Home. The end result of that meeting was that the Personnell Committee recommended to the Nursing Adm. they come back to the committee with a proposal in January.

AMBULANCE COMMITTEE REPORT:

Comm. Earl Wright told the Commissioners that the ambulance service is in good sound financial shape. They are very well pleased with Jeff Washburn and his staff.

LAW ENFORCEMENT REPORT:

Comm. Caldwell met with Mike Wilson and approved his budget transfer and recommends them to the Budget Committee.

FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM:

Comm. Robin Moore makes a motion for Weakley County, Tenn. to withdraw from any participation in the National Flood Insurance Program and dissolve any action it has thur far to this tim taken for participation in this motion. Comm. Bobby Parker seconded it. After a roll call vote, motion passed with 11 for and 7 against.

AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE REPORT:

Comm. James H. Bell made a motion to accept the report and Comm. Lewis Garner seconded it. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

HEW REPORT:

Comm. Johnny Vincent makes a motion to grant Commerical Waste Co. of Union City, Tn. a \$1.00 increase from \$6.50 to \$7.50 for waste pick-up. Comm. Sam Sinclair seconded it and after a roll call vote, motion passed. 17 for and 1 against. (Only if approved by the Oct. 15 meetin of Co. Comm.)

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN:

Motion to have Co. Exec. H. C. Brundige as chairman was made by Comm. Charles Culver and seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN PROTEMPORE:

Motion to elect James H. Westbrook as chairman protempore was made by Comm. James H. Bell and Seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After a show of hands vote, motion carried.
