

MINUTES OF THE COUNTY COURT, DECEMBER 6, 1982 CONTINUING OF OCTOBER MEETING.

On December 6, 1982, the County Court of Weakley County met after a recess of the October 18, 1982 meeting. County Executive H. C. Brundige had a call to order with Comm. Wayne McCreight having the invocation. Roll call was read by Faye Butts, County Clerk with 2 Commissioner absent. They being Commissioner William Mansfield and Fred Morris. Sheriff Mike Wilson opens Court.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: CREATION OF INDUSTRIAL BOARD:

County Executive H. C. Brundige told the Commissioners about the resolution of the Industrial Board. County Attorney Mark Gallien explained to the Commissioners the purpose and obligations of the Industrial Board. After much discussion and many questions, Commissioner Jimmy Westbrook made the motion to take a roll call vote. Comm. Sam Sinclair 2nd the motion. County Clerk Faye Butts took roll call, with 8 nay, 8 yays, 2 passes, 2 absent. It had to have 2/3 majority to pass. The Industrial Board failed on this date. Commissioner Jimmy Westbrook compliments County Attorney for his fine work and research on this matter.

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NOMINATION OF A COUNTY CORNER:

Comm. James Westbrook nominates Jeff Washburn as County Corner. Motion Seconded by Comm. Earl Wright. Upon being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

A discussion was held about the pay of the Coroner. He will not be paid unless he is called by the Sheriff, (Not made in the form of a resolution.)

USE OF SCHOOL BLDG:

Comm. Wayne McCreight said of the Turner-Ward School Bldg. that the County owns this building and is wanting to sell it or rent it. Right now it is in the Board of Education's name. (deed). The board is willing, after Supt. Simmons confers with each member, to give a quit claim deed to the County for this building. The Property Committee met with the past and others of the building and all is agreeable with the conditions. There are three parties interested in this site, they being the City of Dresden, Northwest Tenn. Development Center, and Headstart.

Commissioner McCreight moved the Legislative Body approve the recommendation of the Property Committee to rent the school building to the City of Dresden and Northwest Tn. Development Center for Senior Citizens pursuant to the approval of the Board of Education and transfer of title from the Board of Education to the Weakley County Commissioners. Motion seconded by Comm. Larry Jolley.

Supt. Jerry Simmons says the Weakley County School Board needs to transfer the property and deed to the Weakley County Government. Simmons says he can not speak for the Board, but feels like they will agree to this. Dale Overton of Northwest Tn. Development Center says they will clean up, put curtains up and supply the personnel. It could not afford to do much else as far as maintenance. Everything will be up to the City of Dresden. As of now, the Board of Ed. is paying the insurance and utilities, but when transferred, the Commission will pay. Mr. Brundige called for a show of hands vote to see if transferring the property was in agreement. By a show of hands, motion passes with 15.

ENERGY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM:

Comm. McCreight explained about the Energy Management program and told of the schools which needed insulation, pipe wraps and air curtains. The Property Committee feels the cost of Westview and Dresden schools are justified. As of now, the Committee can not accept bids because it has to be advertised. The committee will go on record later for the need of repair. Motion is now made not to accept any bids at this time. Motion made by Comm. McCreight, seconded by Comm. Gerald Caldwell. By a show of hands, motion carried.

Supt. Simmons ask if it would be alright to get bids, so during the next Court, he could submit them. Comm. McCreight said to have the bids ready so they could submit them.


Comm. Earl Wright said Paul Jones is interested in the constables having a 4 year term instead of a 2 year term. It will be discussed in the January term of Court.

INSURANCE BENEFITS:

Comm. McCreight explained about the insurance the county has on Workmans Comp, and others such as vehicle ins., Prop. ins., boiler and machines ins., The insurance is now with Dresden Ins. Co. Comm. Westbrook ask that Mr. Brundige or Attorney Mark Gallien advise the insurance company to place the deposit, \$60,000.00, with the company with the lowest bid and best policy. Mr. Brundige ask Comm. Westbrook to appoint someone to help him and Mr. Gallien and he volunteered. Comm. Westbrook made the motion to look into this and Comm. Jacky Esch seconded the motion. By a show of hands, motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT:

County Executive H. C. Brundige ask that the County Court be adjourned. Motion made by Comm. Earl Wright and seconded by Comm. Jacky Esch.
