

WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY  
SPECIAL SESSION-OCTOBER 25, 1988

The county commissioners met in special session with Co. Exec. Kerry Killebrew calling the meeting to order and Comm. v. J. Shanklin having invocation. Dept. Ted Phelps opened court and County Clerk Faye Butts called roll with 18 present, and 1 absent. The absent being Comm. Gerald Caldwell, being his father passed away. The Commission will send a card to the family of Comm. Caldwell.

ITEM 1. Electing a General Session Court Judge for Weakley County, Tennessee, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Robert Neal Glasgow.

Comm. V. J. Shanklin nominated Charles Culver from Dresden for the job. Comm. Jimmy Brasfield nominated Robert Hearn, attorney from Greenfield. Comm. David McAlpin nominated Charles McWherter of Martin for the job. Motion to accept these nominations was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. A roll call vote was made with the low vote count eliminated. The vote was Charles Culver 4, Robert Hearn 5, Charles McWherter 9. Charles Culver was eliminated and roll was called again with the two remaining men. The roll was called again and the results being Robert Hearn 7, and Charles McWherter 11. Charles McWherter was elected.
