

RESOLUTION NO. 3

RESOLUTION TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE CLERK ISSUE A DECAL AS EVIDENCE OF PAYMENT OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE TAX

WHEREAS, Weakley County has levied a motor vehicle privilege tax as authorized in Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-8-102, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County levying this tax required the Clerk to issue a decal as evidence of the payment of the tax, and

WHEREAS, the issuance of this decal is expensive and has not been found to be necessary for the enforcement of the privilege tax in Weakley County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners that:

SECTION 1. The provisions of Resolution 1979-20, found in Minute Book _____ at Page _____, which require the issuance of a decal by the County Clerk upon payment of the Weakley County Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax are hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2. Hereafter, the County Clerk shall not be required to issue a decal and motorists shall not be required to display a decal as evidence of payment of the Weakley County Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax.

SECTION 3. Motorists shall continue to be required to retain their copy of the receipt issued by the County Clerk as evidence of payment of the tax.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon its approval by a majority of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, the public welfare requiring it.
