WEAKLEY COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
REGULAR MEETING JANUARY 16, 1990

The Weakley County Legislative body met in regular session on January 16, 1990 at 9:30 a.m. with Co. Executive Kerry Killebrew call to order. Comm. John Salmon held invocation and Sheriff Mike Wilson open court. Roll call was called with 19 present 1 absent, that being Comm. Sam Sinclair. There was the introduction of Tommy Thomas, the new District Attorney and he addressed the commissioners. Approval of the last court minutes was made by Comm. James H. Bell and seconded by Comm. David McAlpin. After being put to a voice vote, minutes approved.

Trustees Report; Motion to accept the trustees report was made by Comm. Vernon Dunn and seconded by Comm. Roger VanCleave. After a voice vote, motion accepted.

General Fund Report: Motion to accept the general fund report was made by Comm. James Harold Bell and seconded by Comm. Charles Culver. After being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

Highway Dept Report: Motion to accept the highway report was made by Comm. Lewis Garner and seconded by Comm. J. T. Walker. After being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

School Dept. Report: Motion to accept the school dept report was made by Comm. J. T. Walker, and seconded by Comm. Vernon Dunn. After a voice vote, motion carried.

Nursing Home Report: Motion to accept the nursing home report was made by Comm. Wayne McCreight and seconded by Comm. John Bucy. After being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

Ambulance Committee Report: Comm. Earl Wright wasn't present at the time of the report, but it was reported that all was going well, with no problems. Motion to accept the report was made by Comm. John Bucy and seconded by Comm. John Salmon. After being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

Budget Committee Report; Resolutions later in meeting.

Financial Management Committee Report; Comm. Vernon Dunn told the commissioners that all was going well, funds are all in balance. No problem. Motion to accept the motion was made by Comm. David McAlpin and seconded by Comm. V. J. Shanklin. After being put to a voice vote, motion carried.

HEW Committee Report; Comm. Vincent, chairman of HEW, reported to the court that the rural sanitation was going well and encouraged people to use the service to get rid of dumping on side roads. Also E911 was moving ahead, talking to other counties with the service, making sure all the bugs are out. Motion to accept this report was made by Comm. Lewis Garner and seconded by Comm. J. T. Law Enforcement Committee Report; Comm. Caldwell reported that there had been no meetings, so they had no report for the commissioners.
